

TOWN OF DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING  
APRIL 11, 2011

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order with two board members, clerk, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren, and 8 residents.

During public Input a resident on Cloverleaf Road asked if the board would look at his culvert for the possibility of installing a larger one.

Constable Gadamus thanked the board for the purchase of new live traps. She reported that there is a large problem with feral cats, and the live traps will be used to capture them.

Park work day will be on May 21, 2011, starting at 8:00 a.m. in both Daufen park in Dale, and Armitage Park in Medina.

The Cornerstone Committee will be holding their annual plant sale and swap on May 21, 2010 in Daufen Park, from 9:00 to noon.

Chief Emmons reported 14 calls for March: Nine First Responder, two accidents, two automatic alarms, and one hot electric smell.

Building Inspector Emmons reported five permits for the month of March.

Annual Tire collection will be held on April 16, 2011 from 8:00 a.m. to noon, in back of the Municipal Building.

Attorney Forsgren will be drafting a hold harmless letter for the Dale Fire and Rescue Dept. This is for a house that will be burned as a training exercise.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve Liquor Licenses and Bartender's licenses for Medina, Dale, Readfield Lions Club provided all paper work is in order. This will be for benefits held on May 7, and 14<sup>th</sup>.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve the purchase of a laptop and docking station not to exceed \$1,350.00.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve treasurer's report subject to audit.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, to approve payment of vouchers 12804 to 12855.
