TOWN BOARD MEETING  
December 13, 2011

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order with two board members, clerk, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren, and eight residents present.

Richard Kloehn was congratulated on his retirement and thanked for the 10 years he has served as Town Supervisor.
