

TOWN OF DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 8, 2011

Supervisor Laabs called the meeting to order with two board members, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren, and 4 residents. Chairperson Wunderlich and Clerk Kelly were not present due to a rescue run for Dale Fire & Rescue.

Lori O'Bright introduced herself as a candidate for Outagamie County Clerk.

Town Engineer Mike Siewert discussed the repair to the Gas pipeline on Midway Road. A \$40,000.00 bond will be required from TransCanadian Pipeline.

Planning Commission held a telephone meeting on Jan 26, 2011. A variance was requested for a holding tank to replace a failed septic system. Due to applying for state funding assistance approval was needed immediately. All members, except Marilyn Dragosh, were contacted and approved the variance.

Dale Fire & Rescue had a total of 13 calls for January. Nine First Responder, one structure fire, two mutual aid for Clayton-Winchester, and one mutual aid for New London.

Five new members have been added to Dale Fire & Rescue Dept: Ben Grossman, Nick Deshaney, Josh Abhold, Derek Ruppel and Eric Hofensperger.

All, but three of the outdoor wood burning furnaces, have been inspected by Building Inspector Emmons.

Minutes of the January meetings were approved in a motion by Supervisor Laabs, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn.

Open Book will be held on April 7, 2011 at the Municipal Building from 3 to 5 p.m.
Board of Review will be on May 9, 2011 at the Municipal Building from 6 to 8 p.m.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to accept the Treasurers' report subject to audit.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn to approve vouchers 12701 to 12736.
