

TOWN OF DALE
TOWN BOARD MEETING
JANUARY 10, 2012

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order with two board members, clerk, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren, and nine residents present.

Chairperson Wunderlich welcomed Chad Degal as the new 2nd Supervisor replacing Richard Kloehn who retired.

During public input, the Fitzgerald family discussed their fund raising efforts to replace the play ground equipment in the Medina Park. The equipment would be in memory of their daughter . For information on contributing to this memorial, please contact the Town Office 779-4609.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Pluff, to approve the Certified Survey Map for Valgene Zuberbier .

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Pluff, to donate \$100.00 to Orphan Animal Rescue.

When weather permits, the ice rink in Daufen Park will be opened.

Discussion on The Dale Fireworks Show was tabled until next month.

The Planning Commission reviewed the Certified Survey Map for Valgene Zuberbier. A request for a Special Exemption for a Cemetery was tabled until more information is made available.

Chief Emmons reported ten calls for December. Six First Responder, one accident, one trash fire, and 2 silo fires.

In 2011 the Dale Fire & Rescue had 110 calls, 66% were First Responder/Accidents. 17% were calls for Caledonia. Mutual aid was given to Clayton Winchester three times, New London twice, and Greenville once. Mutual aid was received form New London once, Fremont once, and Waupaca Haz- Mat once.

There were no building permits for the month of December. In 2011 39 permits were issued, six for new homes.

Attorney Forsgren has sent a letter to Hubert Dorschner's Attorney regarding property owned by Mr. Dorschner.

Letters were also sent to two individuals that are in non-compliance of the Outdoor Wood Burning Furnace Ordinance 2:13.

A resident asked if the Town had any ordinances regarding shoveling snow on sidewalks. The Town does not have an Ordinance for sidewalks. Residents are asked that they keep their sidewalks shoveled and not to put the snow into the road.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Pluff, to approve the Bartender's License for Rebecca Arndt for Jimmers provided all paper work is in order and all fees are paid.

Minutes of the December meetings were approved in a motion by Chairperson Wunderlich, seconded by Supervisor Pluff.

Treasurer report was approved subject to audit in a motion by Chairperson Wunderlich, seconded by Supervisor Degal.

Vouchers 13372 to 13414 were approved for payment in a motion by Supervisor Pluff, and seconded by Supervisor Degal.

Meeting adjourned.
