

TOWN OF DALE ANNUAL MEETING
APRIL 12, 2011

Chairperson Wunderlich called the annual meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with 34 residents present.

The newly elected Town Officials and Dale Sanitary board members were sworn in:

Chairperson Wunderlich starting his 6th term and has also served 2 terms as Supervisor

1st Supervisor Tom Pluff starting his 1th term in office

2nd Supervisor Richard Kloehn starting his 6th term has previously been a Supervisor and Clerk

Clerk Marcia Kelly beginning her 11th term

Treasurer Erica Siewert beginning her 7th term

Constable and Humane Officer Sandy Gadamus beginning her 6th term

Jim Emmons, Dale Sanitary District 1

Motion by Tom Plaski, seconded by John Hengel, to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2010 Annual Meeting Minutes.

Motion made by John Hengel, seconded by Shawn Oligney, to accept the Financial Report for 2010.

Sergeant Shawn Oligney from the Outagamie County Sheriff's Dept. spoke. If any resident has any concerns or questions they can contact any Town Board member and that person can contact Sergeant Shawn Oligney.

Shane Griesbach Outagamie County Supervisor for the 34th district spoke. The County board has agreed on the union contracts at a saving of 6 million dollars. The County Board is working on redistricting due to the 2010 census. At this time there are two plans being presented, one with the current 36 Supervisors and one with 31 Supervisors.

Chairperson Wunderlich discussed updates for Dale Fire and Rescue: six new members have been added: Nick Deshaney, Josh Abhold, Eric Hopfensberger, Derek Ruppel, Nate Pluff, and Ben Grossman.

Dale Fire and Rescue is also looking for Explorers. Any 16 year old boy or girl that is interested should contact Fire Chief Jim Emmons.

Raffle tickets for the Dale Fire and Rescue Dept. will be mailed shortly. The drawing will take place after the Fireworks at Yesteryear in the Park.

Jim and Elayne Emmons have donated \$10,000.00 towards the new tanker chassis this year; bringing that total to \$40,000.00. They have also donated a set of stabilizer jacks, plus miscellaneous items.

This year the Town Board will be replacing the play ground equipment in Armitage Park.

Road work was discussed and depending on the State Budget will determine what work will be done.

The snow fall for this winter was the 6th snowiest on record. The board apologizes for any damage that was done to resident's lawns.

The railroad has notified the Town that at a future date crossing gates will be installed at the following crossings: Whitney, Depot, Hunters Road, School Road, and Shakey Lake.

A presentation was given by Renewegy on the installation of two Wind Turbines for the Municipal Building.

After lengthy discussion, a motion was made by Tom Plaski, seconded by Eugene Bruss, to approve the purchase of two wind turbines contingent on incentives being obtained. A show of hands approved the motion at 8:30 p.m. with 27 for and 2 opposed.

Cornerstone Committee will be holding their annual plant sale and swap on May 21, 2011, along with Park work day. Yesteryear in the Park will be held on June 25, 2011. The committee is considering changing the name of Yesteryear in the Park.
