

**TOWN OF DALE**  
**TOWN BOARD MEETING**  
**SEPTEMBER 8, 2009**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order with three board members, clerk, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren and 4 residents.

During public input, Bill Schroeder thanked the Dale Fire and Rescue Dept for their participation in the welcome home for Brandon Rudie.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to release the line of credit for Pat Niles for black topping Timber Creek Road.

Residents are reminded that motorized vehicles are not allowed on the walking trail or in any Town Park. The exception to this would be motorized wheelchairs. All dogs are to be leashed when in the parks, and owners are to clean up after their pets.

Chief Emmons reported 10 calls for August. Five First Responder, three accidents, one garage explosion, and one animal rescue.

A mutual aid contract has been signed with New London Fire; both departments will be called for structure fires in Caledonia.

Building Inspector Emmons reported two permits for August.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to approve Outagamie County payment for Pine Grove Cemetery.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve minutes from the August meetings.

After reviewing the report from the janitor, Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to deny the security deposit for the rental from August 28, 2009.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, to make the following changes to the Municipal Building rental agreement: The charge for decorating the evening before will be increased to \$25.00 for rental of half of the hall, and \$50.00 for rental of the entire hall. The hall will not be opened until after 5:00 p.m for decorating.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to accept the Treasurer's financial report subject to audit.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs to approve vouchers 11689 to 11724 for payment.

Meeting adjourned.
