

**TOWN OF DALE TOWN BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 10, 2009**

Chairperson Wunderlich called the meeting to order with two board members, clerk, treasurer, Attorney Forsgren, and 7 residents present.

During public input a resident brought to the board's attention that the flag in front of the Municipal Building was not always being lowered at the appropriate times. The board apologized, and proper procedure will be taken in the future.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve the Certified Survey Map for Leroy and Sudy Groeschel.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve the Certified Survey Map for Dave and Cindy VanderZanden.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to approve the Certified Survey Map for Steve Grunwald.

Snowplowing contracts with MCC and T. Johnson were approved.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, to approve the purchase of a dog kennel for the constable.

The Town Board, Clerk, Fire Chief and Town Attorney will meet with Caledonia's Town Board on November 16, 2009 to discuss the renewal of the fire agreement.

Building Inspector Emmons reported 7 permits for the month of October.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich, to approve the minutes of the October meetings.

Supervisor Laabs motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to approve the Bartender License for Jacob Krenke, provided all paper work is in order and all fees are paid.

Chairperson Wunderlich motioned, seconded by Supervisor Kloehn, to accept the Treasurer's report subject to audit.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to approve the bond for the Treasurer's Tax collection.

Vouchers 11798 to 11837 were approved for payment in a motion by Supervisor Laabs, seconded by Chairperson Wunderlich.

Supervisor Kloehn motioned, seconded by Supervisor Laabs, to adjourn.
